

May 10 Regular meeting



Have fun with colors and make your own design as your strips of fabric are being sewn together. Fees for the workshop are \$40 for members and \$50 for non-members.

June 14 <u>Election</u> of officers for next year. Last meeting before summer break. Christmas block exchange...the theme is "TREES"... any type of tree on a muslin background 12 1/2" unfinished block.

September 13 <u>Regular meeting.</u> Our first meeting in the fall.

September 25 & 26 "THREE-IN-ONE" workshop with Agnes Boal. Three very different quilt tops can be created from strip piecing, cutting, repiecing. In this hands-on, no pressure workshop many tips will be included to help you in your quilt-making. Three quilts will be well underway at the conclusion of the workshop.
