

Festival Meeting January 13, 1969

Lutz/Phillips that the minutes be adopted as read. Carried.

Lutz/Brien that the treasurer's report be adopted as read. There is a bank balance of \$992.40. Carried.

Lutz/Daneluk that we contribute 5¢ an entry to the B.C. Music Federation. Carried.

Adjudicator:

A letter was read from Mrs. Carbutt and Mr. Archbold asking certain questions. The secretary is to reply to these.

We heard from Capt. Gayfor who is now in Galt, Ontario stating that our letter had just reached him.

Mr. Carbutt from Prince George has written to say that he will do the instrumental and some vocal and ~~speech-arts~~ choral work.

There has been no word on the Town Grant.

Brien and Raham will organize the publicity for the cover and poster contest.

Danaluk/Lowe that the trophy report be adopted as read. Carried. 64 letters asking for contributions have been sent out. Replies have been received. The secretary will write Peace River Block News for certificates.

Members were asked to bring all Festival material to next meeting to discuss what shall be done with it. (tape recorder etc.)

The Gala Programme was discussed and due to the fact of such good local talent and the difficulty of obtaining outside talent-- the gala programme was voted down. Drama awards will be presented on the last day of the festival and a Grande Finale will try to be organized for the Music and Dancing Sections.

Box Sets-- there was a discussion of this and it was decided to keep to the rules and regulations.

Daneluk/Lutz that we put the sheet music and various drama books in the care of Rosemary Callendar District Librarian of School District #60.
Carried.

Programme Meeting

The was a big discussion of the entry limit rule. It seems that the syllabus was a little confusing.

Darnall/ Weicker that we interpret the entry limit rule as :
if there are four divisions of a grade 7 class in a school
then that school is entitled to 8 entries from that school.
Carried.

Weicker/ Davidson that this interpretation be sent to Trembly School. Carried.

It was also noted that several students in the high school plays are in several plays (opposed to the entry limit of competing once in a section). As there were no other entries but from North Peace they are being advised that had there been other competitors entered.. the rules would have been strictly adhered to.
