You are invited to submit up to two entries in each of the categories for the Regional Juried Art Show to be held at the Fort St. John Art Gallery in the Totem Mall from April 4 to 10, 1987. Selected works will be sent to Images and Objects to be held in Cowichan-Duncan on Vancouver Island, May 31, 1987. Categories are listed on the invitation card.

The Peace Country Juried Art Show is sponsored this year by the Fort St. John Community Arts Council with the financial assistance of the Assembly of B.C. Arts Councils and the Peace River Liard Regional District Arts Council.

Entries will be judged on originality, artistic merit, and workmanship by two jurors selected by the Assembly of B.C. Arts Councils. The entry fee is \$8.00 for each entry, non refundable, and must accompany the entry form to be post marked by March 13, to Box 6474, Fort St. John, B.C. V1J 4K5, or to be dropped off at the Artspace, 10007 100 Street (lower level). Cheques should be made payable to the FSJ Community Arts Council. Art work is to be delivered to the Art Gallery in the Totem Mall by April 1, 5 P.M.

All pieces must be labelled with the name of the artist, address, title, medium and value. Please use accompanying forms for this purpose.

All artists and guests are invited to attend the preview reception on Friday, April 3, from 7 to 9 P.M. at the Art Gallery in the Totem Mall.

The Fort St. John Juried Show Committee will package and send the selected works to Images and Objects. The Committee will take care in handling all artwork. However, the INSURANCE, INCLUDING TRANSIT, IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ARTIST.

REGIONAL JURIED ART SHOW DEADLINE COMING

All artists in the Peace Country are invited to enter works in the 1987 Regional Juried Art Show to be held in Fort St. John from April 4 to 10. The deadline date for entry forms is March 13. Art works can be delivered April 1 to the Art Gallery in the Totem Mall, Fort St. John.

Regional Juried Shows are held annually throughout British Columbia under the direction of the Assembly of Arts Councils. Twenty art works are selected from each region to go to the Images and Objects Provincial Show. Before appearing in the Images and Objects Show, selected regional works were juried again at the B.C. Festival of Arts in Prince George. Last year, Images and Objects was held by the B.C. Pavilion in conjunction with Expo '86.

Dawson Creek artist Laine Dahlen entered a large painting, "The Keeper", which was selected as the B.C. Pavilion Choice at Images and Objects. "The Keeper" was among three art works from the thousands entered at the regional level that received special awards at Images and Objects. A photograph of "The Keeper" is featured on the invitation for submissions at the 1987 Regional Juried Show.

The 1987 Regional Juried Show is organized by a committee of the Fort St. John Community Arts Council under the direction of Linda Scarfo. The North Peace Art Society has offered the spacious Art Gallery in the Totem Mall for the show and will hang the show on April 2. The adjudicators who will come from outside the province will choose twenty pieces for Images and Objects.

Images and Objects is planned for Cowichan-Duncan on May 31 as part of the B.C. Festival of the Arts. Some artists from each region will be chosen to receive subsidized travel and accommodation. For further information: phone 785-1986 Artspace.
