

## 20/20 Vision - A Regional Reflection Regional Textile Exhibition in Chetwynd



In August 2002, over 3000 textile lovers will be descending on Vancouver for "Convergence 2002", the North American bi-annual textile convention. The Crafts Association of BC (CABC) is partnering with interested Community Arts Councils to develop a series of regional textile exhibits to take place in the spring of 2002 throughout the province. A selection of pieces from each regional exhibit will be chosen to travel to Vancouver to be included in the CABC's Gallery on Grandville Island which will coincide with "Convergence 2002".

The CABC Exhibition will be entitled 20/20 - A Regional Reflection and will include all forms of textile art, from basketry and tapestry, to quilting and beyond. The exhibit will consist of work that reflects the artists

regional area, whether it be a realistic, historical, an environmental statement, or perhaps even a personal story of artist's own history of the area.

Participants will be limited to submitting work to a maximum of 20"x20"x10" when displayed. The Chetwynd Community Arts Council has offered to host this exhibition for our region. "Call for Entry" forms will be distributed when available, with the deadline for entry in January 2002. Dates for the exhibition has been tentatively set for April 26th - 30th.
