An opening show would be held at the Artworks Gallery on January 25, 1991 with twenty of his originals owned by local people.

Advertising will be distributed throughout Northern B.C. and Alberta targeting Grande Prairie, Whitehorse, Prince Rupert, Fort Nelson, Dawson Creek and Prince George and Fort St. John.

KENNETH A. FERRIS, is a completely self-taught artist and has been drawing wildlife since early childhood.

Ken's work has been featured in one man and group exhibitions throughout North America, including "Profiles of a Heritage", Images of Wildlife by British Columbia Artists, and "Birds in Art" 1989, at the Leigh Yawkey Woodson Art Museum, Wausau, Wisconsin.

In 1984, Ken was named "Artist of the Year" by Ducks Unlimited Canada.

His donations of artwork have raised many thousands of dollars for important conservation organizations, including the World Wildlife Fund, and Ducks Unlimited.

Ken was selected as one of 30 international artists to paint a work for the limited edition art book, "Waterfowl of North America", commemorating Ducks Unlimited Canada's, 50th anniversary. He has been featured in numerous articles in major newspapers and magazines.

Ken's paintings are much sought after by collectors and his work is part of numerous permanent and private collections throughout Canada, United States and Mexico.

Ken lives with his wife Jasmine and their cat "P.T." and works in his studio in Prince George.
