The Fort St John Workshop Players would like to make an application for a grant under the Arts Council Grant for this year.

With the assistance of the Grant received <sup>ei</sup> ~~this~~ <sup>last</sup> year, our Group was able to meet the production expenses of G.B.Shaw's "Pygmalion", which was shown to an appreciative audience in North Peace Senior Secondary School Auditorium. After the receipts and expenses of this production were finalised we managed to have a credit balance in the bank. Without the assistance of the Arts Council Grant we would have been unable to go ahead with such a large and enjoyable production.

This year we have an expanded membership of enthusiastic workers with plans for producing two plays before Christmas, at least two for the Peace Country Drama Festival and ~~two~~ plays during the spring of 1970.

One of these plays, "the Odd Couple", by Neil Simon, is already in rehearsal with production date scheduled for October 18.
