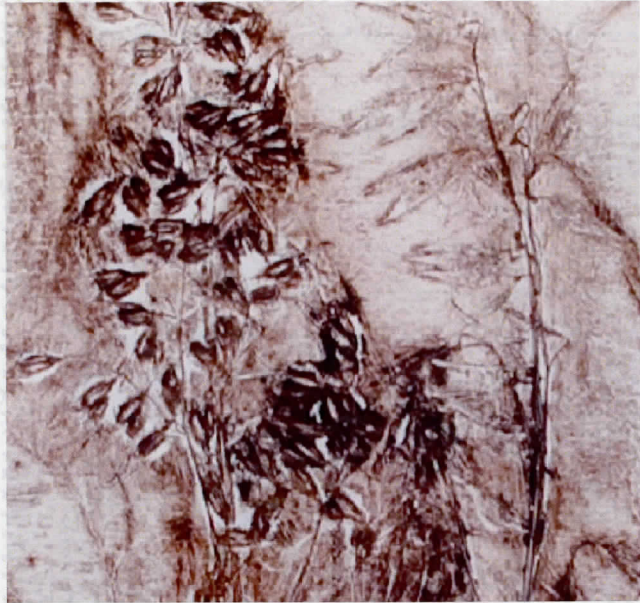

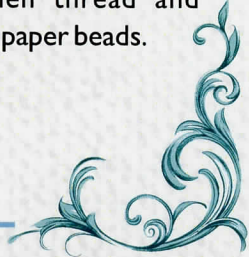
**“EARTH AND PINE

Artist Statement: Earth and Pine is a collaboration of two sisters: Lynette, a fibre artist and Linda a potter, both born and raised in Dawson Creek. The Renaissance pieces are symbolic of the relationship between the dying pine trees and the earth that nourished them until the Mountain Pine Beetle infestation took its toll. Now the decaying trees will replenish that same soil from which will sprout new seedlings, repeating the cycle of growth.

Piece is made from pit-fired clay with pine needles, waxed linen thread and handmade paper beads.

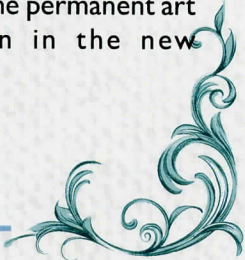
“SHALL WE DANCE”
