Partnerships

The Peace-Liard Regional Arts Council (PLRAC), works for the advancement of the arts in partnership with such organizations as the Canadian Conference of the Arts, the Assembly of BC Arts Councils, the BC Touring Council, the BC Museums Association, municipal, provincial and federal governments, other regional districts, and with its own member groups, the Community Arts Councils of the Peace-Liard Region.

Advocacy

PLRAC brings regional cultural needs to the attention of all levels of government by attending government meetings, by distributing council minutes and newsletters and through continuing involvement with the Assembly of BC Arts Councils.

Arts Beat Newsletter

PLRAC publishes a regional arts newsletter four times a year. The newsletter covers topical information on regional events, programs and activities as well as any issues which may impact the cultural development of the region.

Art Collection

Annually PLRAC sponsors the purchase of one work of art from a regional artist. This work is given in public trust to the Regional District of the area in which it is purchased, either the Peace River Regional District or the Fort Nelson-Liard Regional District. This donation is presented on behalf of PLRAC by its member community arts councils in turn.



Regional Juried Art Exhibition

Annually, PLRAC co-hosts the Regional Juried Art Exhibition with one of its member community arts councils. This Juried Art Exhibition is the regional component of the BC Festival of the Arts. Works chosen are displayed at the Images and Objects Exhibition held each year in conjunction with the Provincial Festival. The BC Festival of the Arts is the largest one of its kind in Canada and the co-ordination of the Regional Exhibit through its member arts councils is part of PLRAC continuing support for the visual arts.

Information/Training

PLRAC is available to all sectors of the community for information sharing. As well, the regional council provides assistance to the community arts councils through its co-ordinator or any of its executive officers upon request.
