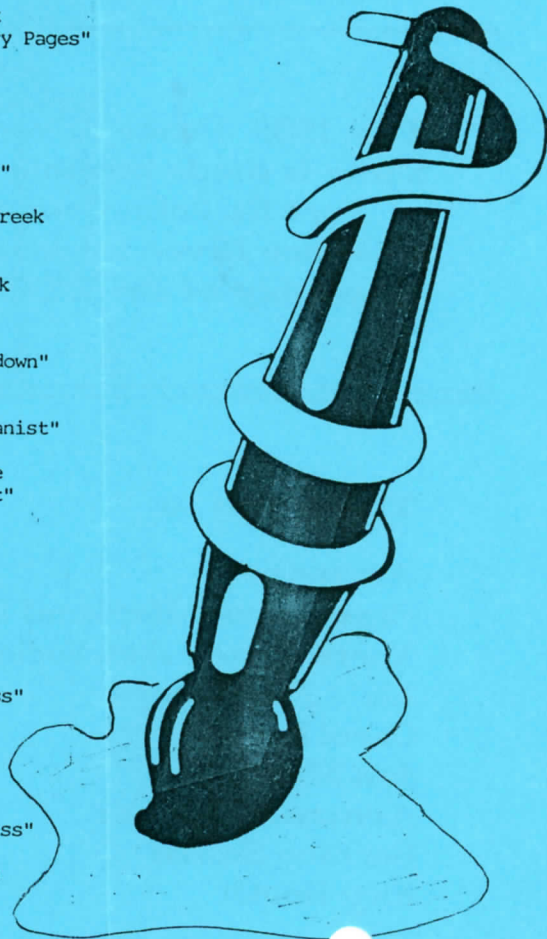

6. Ceramics - fired clay; glazed or unglazed
7. Sculptures or carvings
8. Fabric Art
9. Photography: state whether printed or developed by the
artist
10. Collage: multi-media two dimensional effect

WORKS DIFFICULT TO SHIP OR MOVE DUE TO SIZE; WEIGHT; OR FRAGILITY
SHOULD NOT BE ENTERED
