CRITERIA:

- All media, sizes, and types of work are eligible.
- Open to artists of all ages, from all cultures.
- Only original art work is eligible. No copies from magazines, mechanical reproductions, kits or commercial molds.
- Works previously displayed in the Peace-Liard Regional Exhibition are ineligible.
- Work must have been completed after January 2001.
- Limit of 2 entries per artist.
- Entry Fees: \$10.00 per entry.
- Works difficult to move due to size, weight or fragility should not be entered.

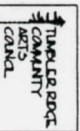
CATEGORIES

OPEN: artists may submit work to the open category and be represented by projects they are currently committed to.

WONDER OF WATER (W.O.W.) THEME:

- how we relate to water and our environment.
- sponsored nationally by federal grants.
- A separate "People's Choice" will be chosen for a \$300 prize.
- There will be a W.O.W. prize of \$500

– selected works tour the Peace-Liard Region.



TOURING NOTES

While all media sizes and types of art works are eligible for selection, and all works chosen by jury will be recognized as successful entries, the hosting art councils reserve the right to limit the exhibition and touring of specific works of art if to do so would be deemed to be detrimental to the artwork itself or would impose inordinate handling or display problems on the host gallery.

EXHIBITION REQUIREMENTS

Presentation – work must be ready for hanging and suitably prepared for exhibition: appropriately framed or stretched, and include any specific exhibit instructions. The Regional arts Council reserves the right to the final decision on the display of the works for the regional tour. Work will not be released prior to 3pm, Sunday, May 11, 2003.

Artists must sign the entry form waiver (C) All works must be properly labeled on the back with the name, address, phone number, title, selling price, and a value for insurance purposes if the work is not for sale.

The Artist statement (Form A) will be displayed with the artwork. Please use the form provided.

Sales: The hosting Arts Council will retain a 35% commission on works that are sold.

*Insurance is the responsibility
of the artist.*
