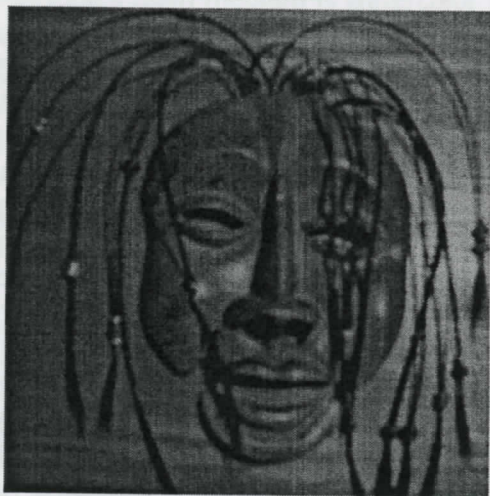

Criteria

- All media, sizes and types of work will be accepted.
- Open to artists of all ages from all cultures.
- Only original artwork is eligible. No copies from magazines, mechanical reproductions, kits or commercial molds.
- Works previously displayed in the Peace Liard Regional Juried Art Exhibit are ineligible.
- Work must have been completed after January 2008
- Limit of **THREE** entries per artist.
- Entry fees are \$10 per entry (\$5.00 for students).
- Works difficult to move or install due to size, weight or fragility should not be entered.

Categories

A. OPEN

Artists may submit original work to the Open category that is representative of their own creativity and expressions.

B. STUDENT

This category is specifically for artists attending Middle or Senior Secondary schools within the Peace Liard Region (Home School students can also apply in this category).

C. CLASS PROJECT

Submissions to this category are works created in a class, under the direction of an instructor. Work can be by an individual artist or a collaboration.

Exhibition Requirements

PRESENTATION

All work must be ready for hanging and/or suitably prepared for exhibition.

All specific exhibit instructions should be included with the work.

The hosting organizations have the right to the final decision on the exhibition of the works.

TO ENTER:

1. **Complete Entry Form A.**
2. **Complete Artist Statement Form C** optional and send with the call for entry form

Mail Form A and **artist statement** with a cheque or money order for \$10.00 per piece (\$5.00 for students) to:

Complete Form B and attach it to the back of your work. All work must be properly labeled on the back with the Title, Artist's Name, Address, Phone, Selling Price and/or Value (for insurance purposes) and Category. Send or bring work to:
