Dr. Lillian Upright is a St. Albert piano teacher and recitalist, choral director and grandmother who, in 1988, became the first person ever to be awarded a Doctor of Music in piano performance from the University of Alberta.

Early piano studies with pioneer Alberta music teacher, Madame Jenny Le Saunier, led to the degrees of A Mus (gold medallist), ARCT, LRSM (highest mark in Canada) and L Mus. She combined marriage and raising a family of five sons with activities as a church musician (she was gold medallist for her ARCT in organ), and teaching piano, a profession she continues to enjoy after nearly four decades. Her university studies began in 1976 and led to an undergraduate degree in psychology, then a Master's in music and finally the Doctorate under mentors Dr. Robert Stangeland and Dr. Ernesto Lejano.

Dr. Upright examines for the Western Board of Music, con-

ducts workshops (including an annual summer "Revival Workshop" for piano teachers) and adjudicates at music festivals throughout western Canada.

The piano portion of the Festival will take place at the Peace Lutheran Church on March 12 from 7-9:30 p.m., at the Mennonite Church March 13 and 14 from 9 a.m. to 9:30 p.m., March 15 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., March 16 from 9 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. and March 17 from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.



William H. Street, saxophonist and conductor, joined the University of Alberta in July 1988. He has appeared as soloist with orchestras and bands throughout Europe, North America and Asia. He holds advanced degrees from Northwestern University, the Conservatoire National de Bordeaux, France, and the Catholic University of America. His major teachers have been Frederick L. Hemke, Jean-Marie Londeix, George Etheridge, Frederick Ockwell and John P. Paynter. Dr.

Street has a strong interest in the music education of young people and appears frequently as clinician and adjudicator throughout North America.

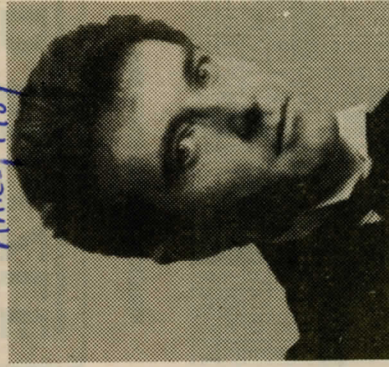
The Band portion of the Festival will take place at the Gospel Tabernacle Church, March 15 from 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and March 17 from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. The instrumental portion will take place March 16 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Stephen Boswell was born in Northampton, England in 1951.

He began playing guitar at the age eight. At first he played popular and jazz styles, but at 13 he attended his first Classical Guitar concert given by John Williams in the local cathedral and then he decided to study the Classical guitar exclusively.

Stephen obtained honours passes in all of his Associated Board of the Royal College of Music examinations while at Grammar School in Britain. After leaving school, he served for one and a half years in the British Merchant Navy as an Officer Cadet before choosing to resume his formal music studies at the Royal College of Music in London. After obtaining an A.R.C.M. and L.R.C.M. from this institution he established a peripatetic classical guitar program in the Northamptonshire schools before coming to Canada in 1975.

Since his arrival in Canada, Stephen has played nine extensive concert tours in the Pacific North West, to great



acclaim. He is on the faculties of Vancouver Community College and Capilano College and has released three recordings of classical guitar music all of which have and still are receiving considerable airplay on CBC and American Public Radio.

Stephen teaches a summer school at Courtenay Youth Music Centre on Vancouver Island, in July and August each year.

In 1984 and 1987 Stephen was invited to perform as a part of Canadian Showcase at the prestigious Toronto Guitar festivals and in 1983 was invited by the Orozco String Company to participate in the 10th Concurso Internacional de la Guitarra in Vina del Mar, Chile.

Last year Stephen was the invited guest soloist with both the Okanagan and Kootenay Symphony Orchestras.

The guitar portion of the Festival will be held March 16 at the Gospel Tabernacle Church from 7-9 p.m. Instrumental, band and orchestral strings will be held there from March 15 to 17.

Loree Martin Vellner has been in Dance since childhood: As a feature performer in a children's touring show; winner of a number of national and international talent awards; and a professional dancer for stage and television.

She was one of the pioneers in the study and research of kinesthetic awareness for dancers in the early 1970s. She continues to advance in this field, frequently serving as a consultant in the prevention and rehabilitation of dance injuries. Loree is in demand as a lecturer on this subject and was recently guest speaker at an international dance congress in Las Vegas.

Among the qualifications and degrees in dance and related studies, the following are representative: Fellow Member of Scottish Dance Teacher's Alliance and Member of the Scottish Official Board Judge's Panel, Fellow Member of Dance Master's of America, Member of the American Society of Dancing, Member of



Dance in Canada Association and Dance Educators of America, and Member of International Panel for Kinesthetic Studies and Training Analysis.

Loree is an adjudicator and teacher of clinics for ballet students, highland dancers, tap, modern stage, jazz and musical theatre. She conducts master classes in performance dynamics and psychology and is contracted to critique and choreograph for dance companies, professional solo and group performances.

Judging the Highland Dance will take place at the Legion Hall on March 11, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. For the Irish Dance, judging will take place March 12, from noon to 7 p.m. at the Legion Hall.

Barbara Pratt has had extensive Dance training in Tap, Jazz and Ballet in such centres as Regina, Vancouver and Toronto.

Barbara is a Registered Teacher of the Royal Academy of Dancing and a Full Member of the Canadian Dance Teacher's Association (Saskatchewan Branch, Stage Division). She choreographs local musical productions in Regina and has choreographed for the singing troupe, Saskatchewan Express. Barbara has adjudicated Dance Festivals in British Columbia and Ontario.

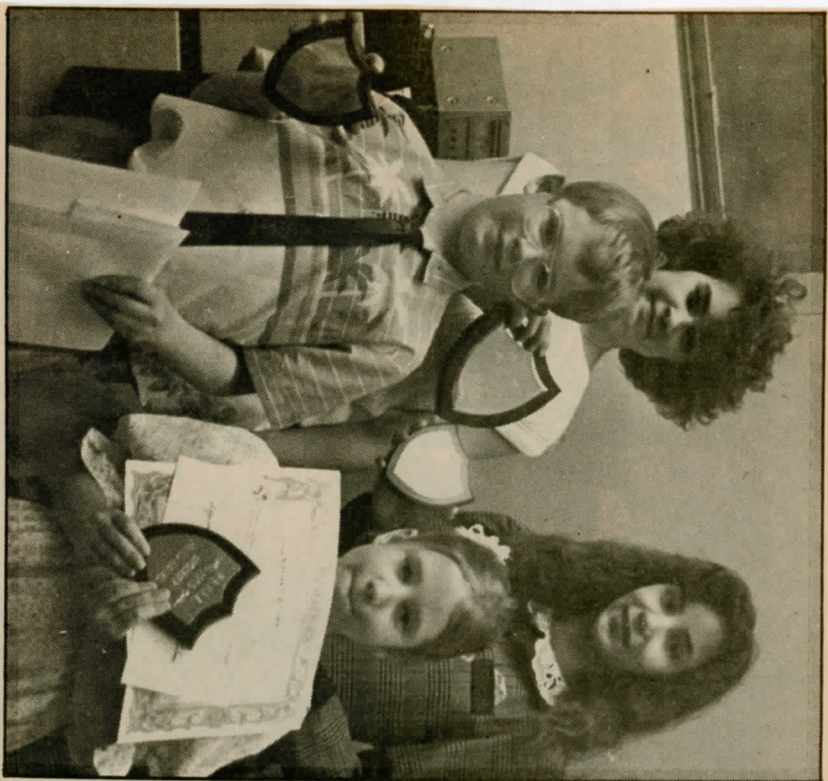

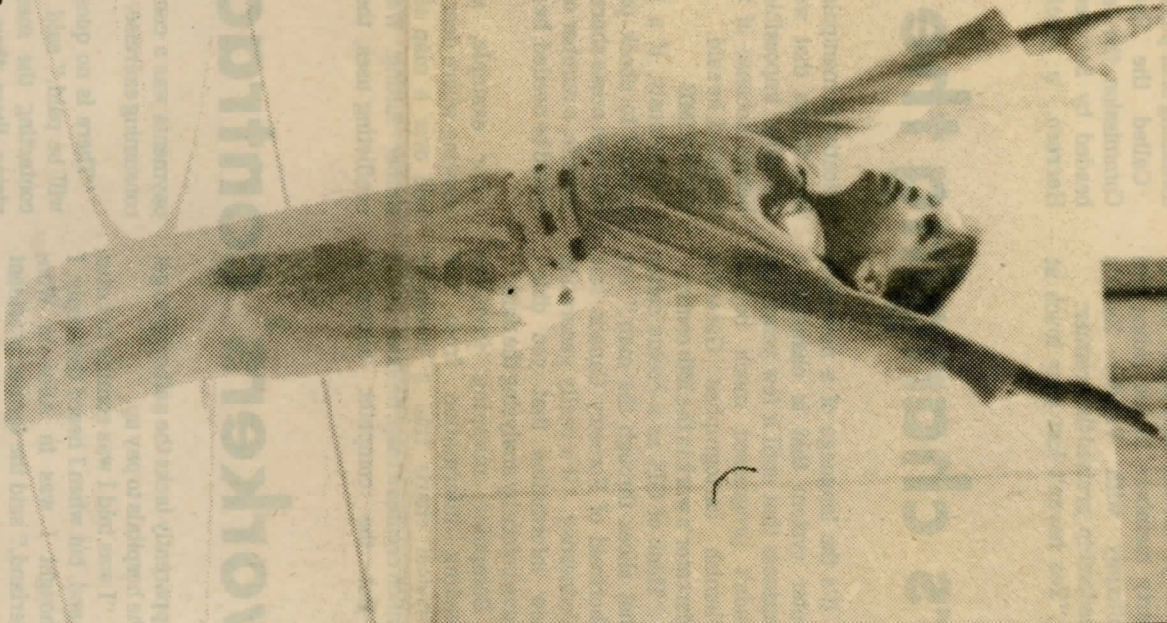

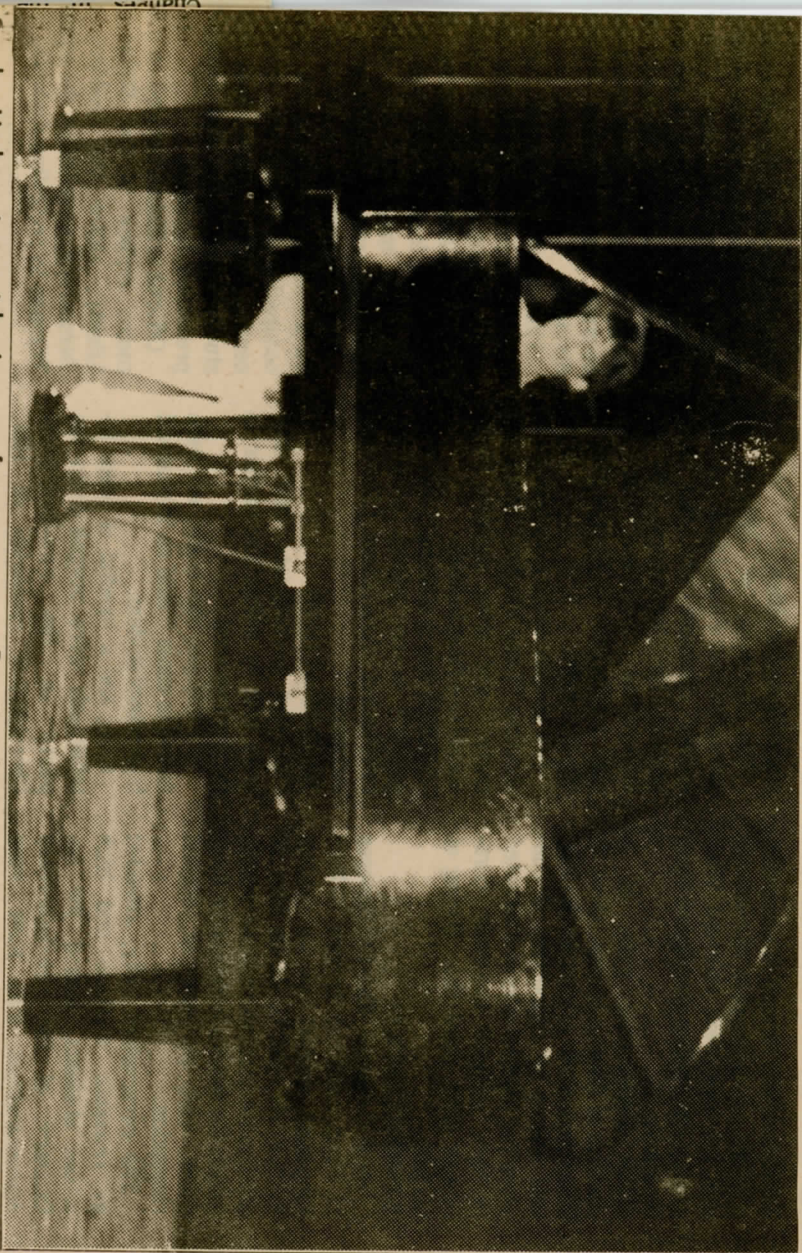

Lindsay played the Morel piece again on Saturday night before several hundred people at the Honors Performance.

She said performing for large audiences is nothing new for her: she's played weddings and Christmas parties, and this June, as

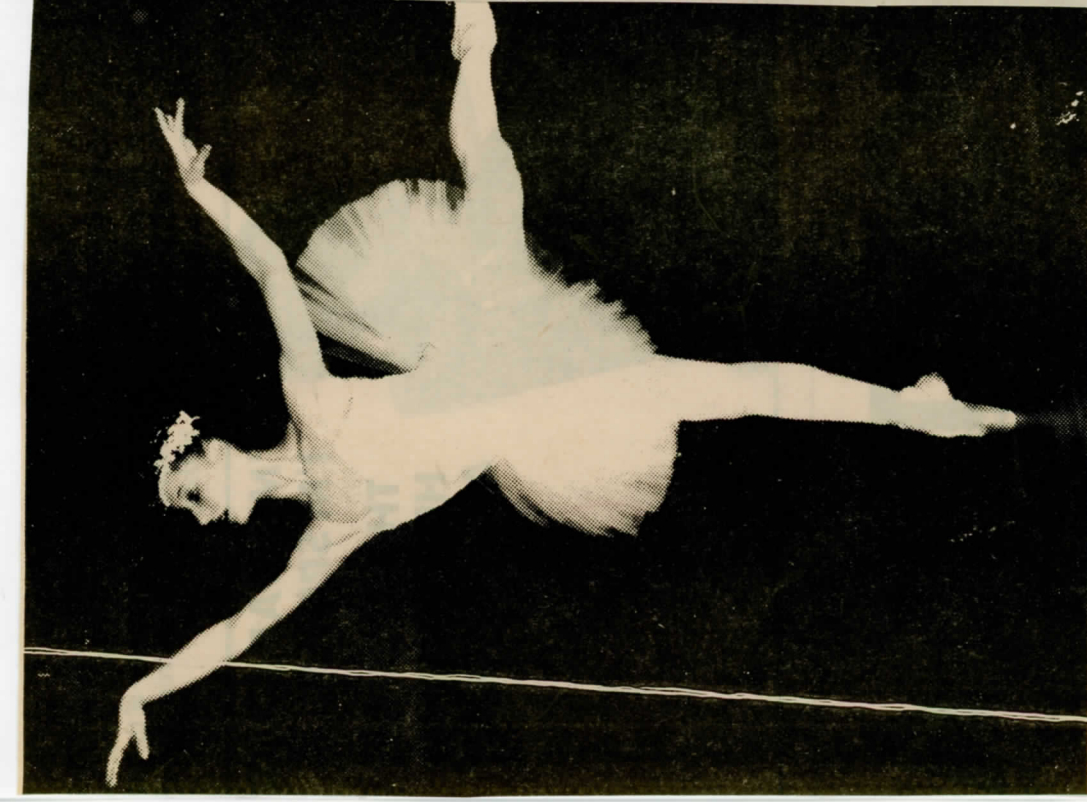
