

The Honours Concert on Sunday, April 21 will attract approximately 450 people and the festival entries usually reach 2000 entries.

The Committee of the North Peace Performing Arts Festival would like to ask for the use of the North Peace Gymnasium from Thursday evening at 6 P.M. until Sunday evening at 10 P.M. The gymnasium would be used for the dance competitions all day Friday and Saturday and the Honours Performance on Sunday. In order to construct a low wooden stage for the dance, we need the Thursday evening for construction. We understand that tap shoes can not be used on the gymnasium floor.

The festival competition result in the top performers representing Fort St. John and region at the B.C. Festival of Arts to be held this next year in North Vancouver in May 1991.
