 - Nothing to report
 - Meetings coming up on July 5th, 6th and 7th in Vernon at Mainstage
 - Yearly zone report is due today; Teela has it written and is just waiting until after this
 meeting to send it in
 - Teela & Stevi have sent in requests to Theatre BC for travel funding (\$1300 total) for Blackbird and Mary's Wedding
 - Treasurer's Report
 - We have enough money to give the winning play \$2000, but they can't cash the cheque until we have the \$1500 RBC Grant from Theatre BC
 - See attached for report
 - Change to report: have received money from Pamela Laventure
 - Adjudicator (Lauren Brotman)
 - Cheque has been written and mailed
 - Festival Summary
 - Less glitches than last year; we improved
 - Did not seem well attended (in general)
 - Number of tickets purchased per night: 32, 23, 35 (includes 4 Festival passes)
 - Approximately 40 45 participants in the Festival (this includes PRZ board and volunteers)
 - Sponsorship was done a little too late
 - Adjudicator seemed happy
 - · As usual, we need more volunteers and board members
 - Decorations were great fun
 - Awards were awesome, and it was great that they were cheaper
 - Discussion: What is the point of Festival?
 - Building community togetherness
 - Building community theatre
 - Offering another outlet to people (theatre literally saves some people from harmful pursuits)
 - We are constantly pushing and pulling to get volunteers, as well as plays to enter
 - Did we achieve our mandate/goals?
 - o If we were supposed to build, then we didn't (currently we are just existing)
 - What are our suggestions for next year?
 - We need more volunteers if we are to build community theatre

- Festival Chair needs a team of at least three people (separate from the board)
- Treasurer needs an assistant
- Have a fundraising team
- Maybe next year we just focus on having theatre workshops instead of a Festival
- Have a dedicated social media volunteer/board director
- How do we get more volunteers?
 - o 1:1 only give 1 person 1 job to do
 - Every volunteer needs to be nurtured and mentored and constantly communicated to
 - Go to Stage North audition days to find people who might be willing to join the PRZ
 - Volunteer management (courtesy of Sue):
 - Clear communication, setting up expectations and following up
 - Don't ask someone to do something you wouldn't be willing to step in and do
 - If we no longer need someone's assistance, thank them and explain we are going in a different direction/made another plan/restructured
