

## A Community Success

Peace Gallery North is pleased to introduce you to the works of our local children. The children entered our Juried Art Competition and those selected, participated in workshops in which they enlarged, and painted their themed design onto a banner. Each of the student's banners represent not only hard work and an outstanding design, but a demonstration of cooperation, creativity, and education.

Many of the students had the opportunity to participate through their class curriculum, while others participated through initiative of their own. School District #60 teachers commented on the seriousness in which the children took on the project. And several Librarians commented on the amount of student research that occurred for this project in our libraries. Students were required to theme their entry artworks to either the Bicentennial of the Fort St. John area, the Fort St. John International Airshow, or the Commonwealth Games.

183 students, aged 6 through to 21, pledged themselves to the creation of our Community Art! The response to the project was amazing, and the pride experienced by the participants during each of the Banner Camps was awe inspiring. Parents would approach project organizers and ask if they could help their children paint, and paint they did! Whole families (many of which admitted to only being able to draw little more than stick men) participated in creating our banners!

To make this project possible Peace Gallery North had to engage in partnership with many parties, including: The City of Fort St. John, from whom we received full support for the project via financial backing, banner spaces/locations, and technical assistance; School District #60, who engaged their staff, principals, teachers and stu-



dents in the project; BC Hydro, who graciously supported the project through a corporate denation, for the inclusion of the Commonwealth theme, and the Fort St. John Airshow, for their financial support. The Totem Mall also heard about our project and trusted us enough to jump aboard. The Alaska Highway News provided continuous coverage and this booklet! The local community minded businesses contributed via banner sponsorships (see page 7)... Please note the inside back last page for further notations of people who made-it-all--happen!

The Banner Camp was not an easy project to take on as much planning, research, and promotion was required. We were fortunate to have a great group of volunteers who believed in the project. We were excited to have cast from <u>Up With People</u> included as volunteers as well as many many dedicated others.

Peace Gallery North is very pleased to have exceeded our expectation and to have experienced such full community support. In the middle of this project I said "never again", but it's with pride, and a sense for our "young artists" accomplishment that I now say "next time..."

## Partnership in Action


