

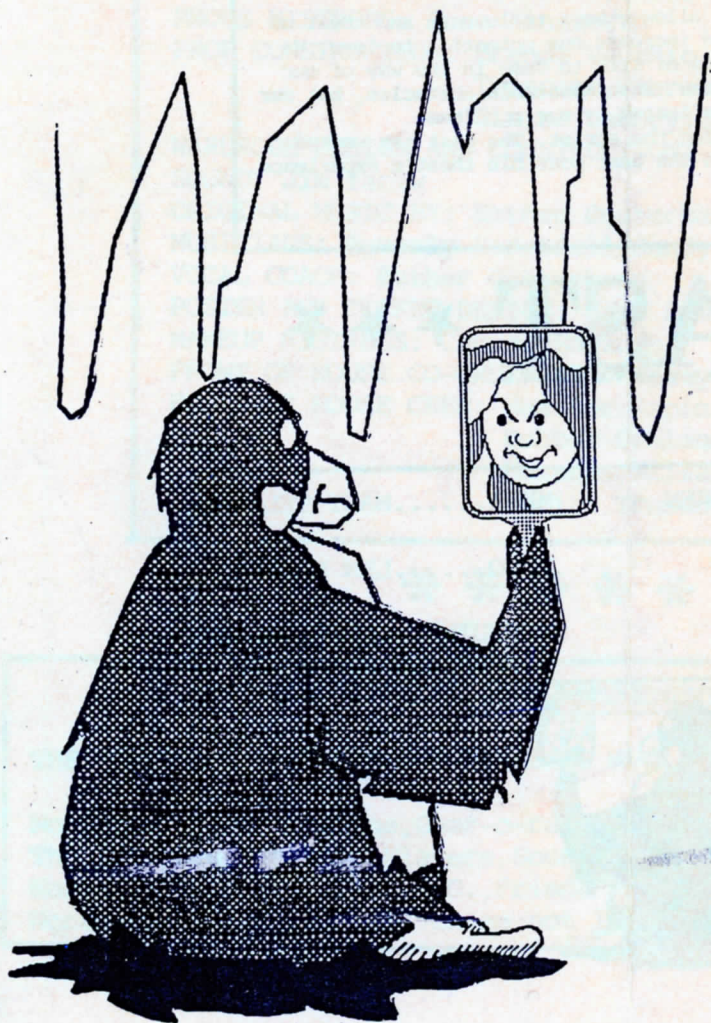

# DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

I first saw "The Lost Mirror" performed 14 years ago. It was a new play and had never been produced. I was immediately moved by its simplicity and its hopeful inspiring message. 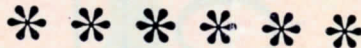
