Selected works from the Peace River show will be on display at the North Peace Art Gallery at the end

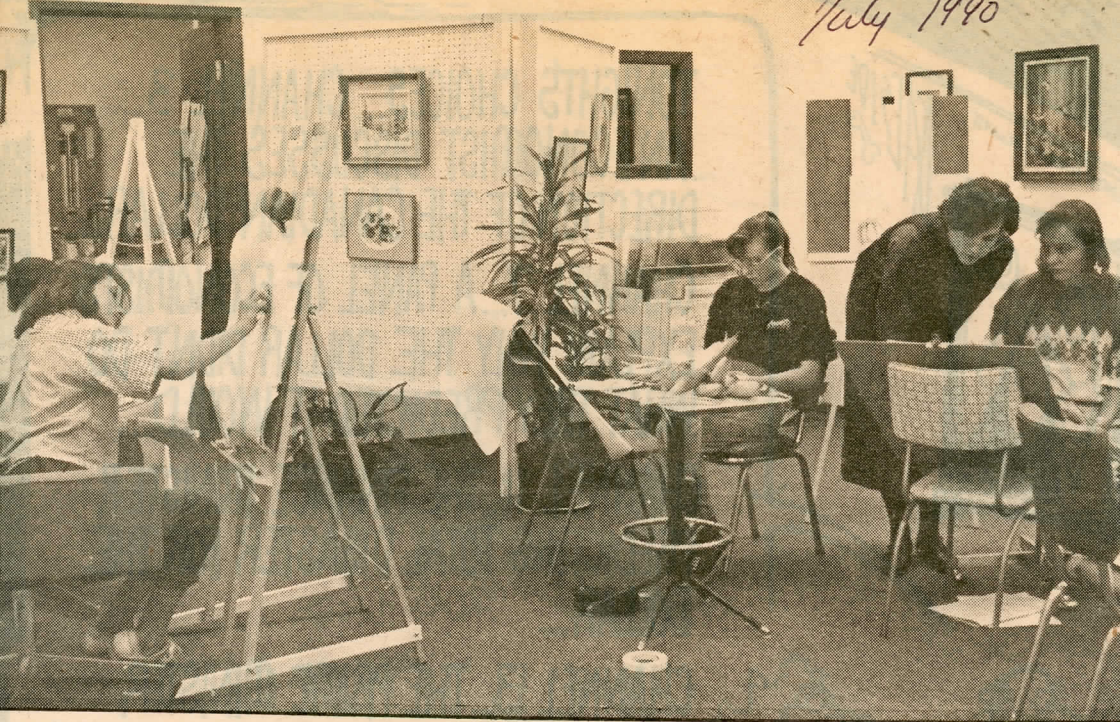
of this month.
