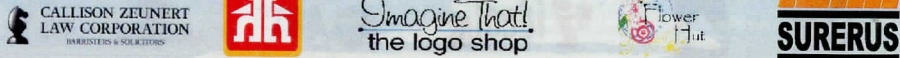

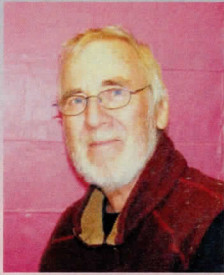

Tony Atkins was an integral part of the creation of the North Peace Cultural Centre and remained an active member of the Centre until his death. He was an early member of Workshop Players and later Stage North Theatre Society. Tony was also an active member with the Peace Valley Environmental Association.

In 1992 Tony was recognized by the community of Fort St. John with a plaque "To those who have dedicated themselves to the enrichment of the performing arts" and in 2006 he was awarded the John Barry Award from Theatre BC for his Outstanding Contribution to the Peace River Zone. In 2001 he served as co-chair of the BC Performing Arts Festival and in 2014 he was nominated as the Cultural Person of the Year. True to form, Tony was pleased that someone else took that spotlight.

To honour Tony and his dedication to the arts and the centre, the North Peace Cultural Centre has decided to dedicate this First Annual Bright Nights in June to him. His guidance, leadership and sense of humour will be greatly missed.

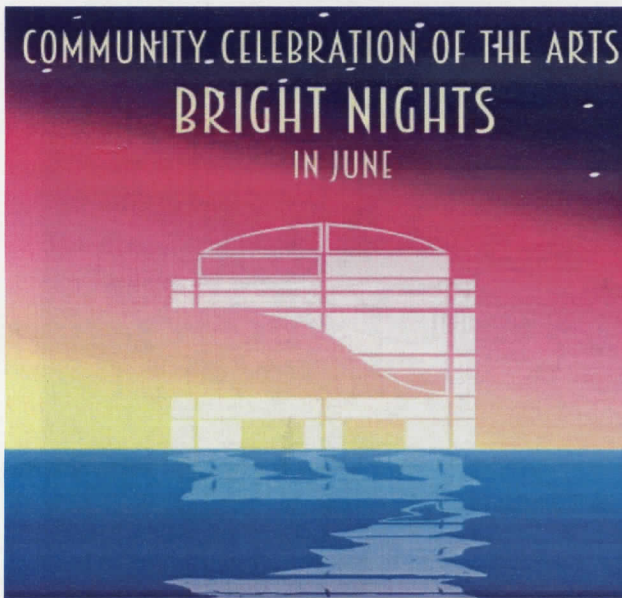

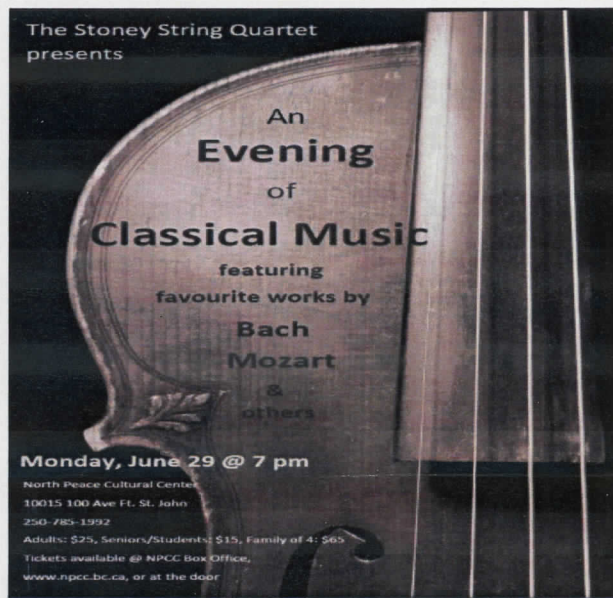
