#### PEACE RIVER-LIARD REGIONAL DISTRICT

#### BY-LAW No. 234

A by-law to submit a question to the Electors of the Defined Portions of Electoral area 'C' and 'B' on participating in the function of constructing and operating a Library-Theatre Complex.

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River-Liard Regional District has been requested to undertake the construction and operation of a Library-Theatre Complex as a function of the Regional District for the member municipalities of the City of Fort St. John, the Village of Taylor, the Defined Portion of Electoral Area 'B', and the Defined Portions I and II of Electoral Area 'C' as described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto;

AND WHEREAS the cost of constructing and operating the Library-Theatre Complex will be apportioned among the participating municipalities on the basis of 100 percent of the assessments for school purposes in the City of Fort St. John and the Village of Taylor and 100 percent of assessments of improvements for school purposes within the defined Portion I of Electoral area 'C' and 50 percent of assessments of improvements for school purposes in the Defined Portion of Electoral Area 'B' and Defined Portion II of Electoral Area 'C', excluding property that is taxable for school purposes only by Special Act, and the amount assessed and levied in the Defined Portions of Electoral areas 'B' and 'C' will be assessed and levied on assessments for improvements only;

NOW THEREFORE, the Regional Board of the Peace River-Liard in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

  A poll shall be taken of the electors qualified to vote within those portions of Electoral area 'B' and 'C' as defined in Schedule 'A' which is attached hereto and forms part of this by-law, in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Act to determine whether or not the electors wish to participate in the function of constructing and operating a Library-Theatre Complex;
- (2)
  A poll shall be taken on the 26th day of April, 1980, between the hours of 8 o'clock in the forenoon and 8 o'clock in the afternoon;
- (3)
  An Advance Ptll shall be conducted at City Hall, Fort St.
  John, B.C., between the hours of 9 o'clock in the forenoon
  and 5 o'clock in the afternoon from the 21st to the 25th days
  of April, 1980, inclusive, and those permitted to vote at the
  Advanced Poll are those who, being qualified to vote, sign a
  statement that they expect to be absent from the area on
  polling day or they are for reasons of conscience prevented
  from voting on polling day.

  The question on the ballot shall read;

"ARE YOU IN FAVOUR OF THE PEACE RIVER-LIARD REGIONAL DISTRICT UNDERTAKING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FORT ST. JOHN, THE VILLAGE OF TAYLOR AND THE DEFINED PORTIONS OF ELECTORAL AREAS "B" AND "C" THE FUNCTION OF CONSTRUCTING AND OPERATING A LIBRARY-THEATRE COMPLEX TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF FORT ST. JOHN AND THE DEBT INCURRED TO CONSTRUCT THIS FACILITY SHALL NOT EXCEED \$3.1 MILLION".

This by-law may be cited as "Peace River-Liard Regional Distriit Library-Theatre Complex Referendum By-law No. 234, 1980".

#### DEFINED PORTION I OF ELECTORAL AREA "C"


Commencing at the north west corner of Township 84, Range 20, West of the sixth meridian, Peace River District; thence easterly approximately 17.5 miles along the northerly boundaries of Township 84 in Ranges 20, 19, and 18 to the point of intersection with the middle line of the Beatton River; thence in a general south easterly direction along the said middle line approximately 8 miles to the point of intersection with the easterly boundary of what would be Section 9, Township 84, Range 17, west of the sixth meridian; thence southerly approximately 9 miles to the point of intersection with the middle line of the main channel of the Peace River; thence in a general north westerly direction approximately 25 miles along the said middle line of the main channel to the point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Township 84, Range 20, West of the sixth meridian; thence northerly approximately 5.5 miles along the said westerly boundary to the aforesaid north west corner, being the point of commencement; save and except all the incorproated areas of Fort St. John and Taylor.

#### DEFINED PORTION OF ELECTORAL AREA "B"; DEFINED PORTION II OF ELECTORAL AREA "C".

Comnencing at the intersection of the British Columbia-Alberta boundary with the middle line of the main channel of the Peace River; thence in a general westerly direction approximately 25 miles along the said middle line of the main channel to the point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Section 28, Township 82, Range 17, west of the sixth meridian, Peace River District; thence northerly approximately 9 miles to the point of intersection with the middle line of the Beatton River; thence in a general north westerly direction approximately 8 miles along the said middle line to the point of intersection with the southerly boundary of Section 1, Township 85, Range 18, west of the sixth meridian; thence westerly approximately 17.5 miles along the southerly boundaries of Township 85, Range 18, 19 and 20 to the south west corner of Township 85, Range 20, West of the sixth meridian; thence southerly approximately 5.5 miles to the point of intersection with the middle line of the main channel of the Peace River; thence in a general south westerly direction approximately 5 miles along said middle line of the main channel to the point of intersection with the westerly boundary of Section 4, Township 84, Range 21, west of the sixth meridian; thence northerly approximately 28.5 miles to the point of intersection with the middle line fo the Bluberry River; thence in a general north easterly direction along the said middle line for approximately 16 air miles to the confluence of the Blueberry Rivers;


