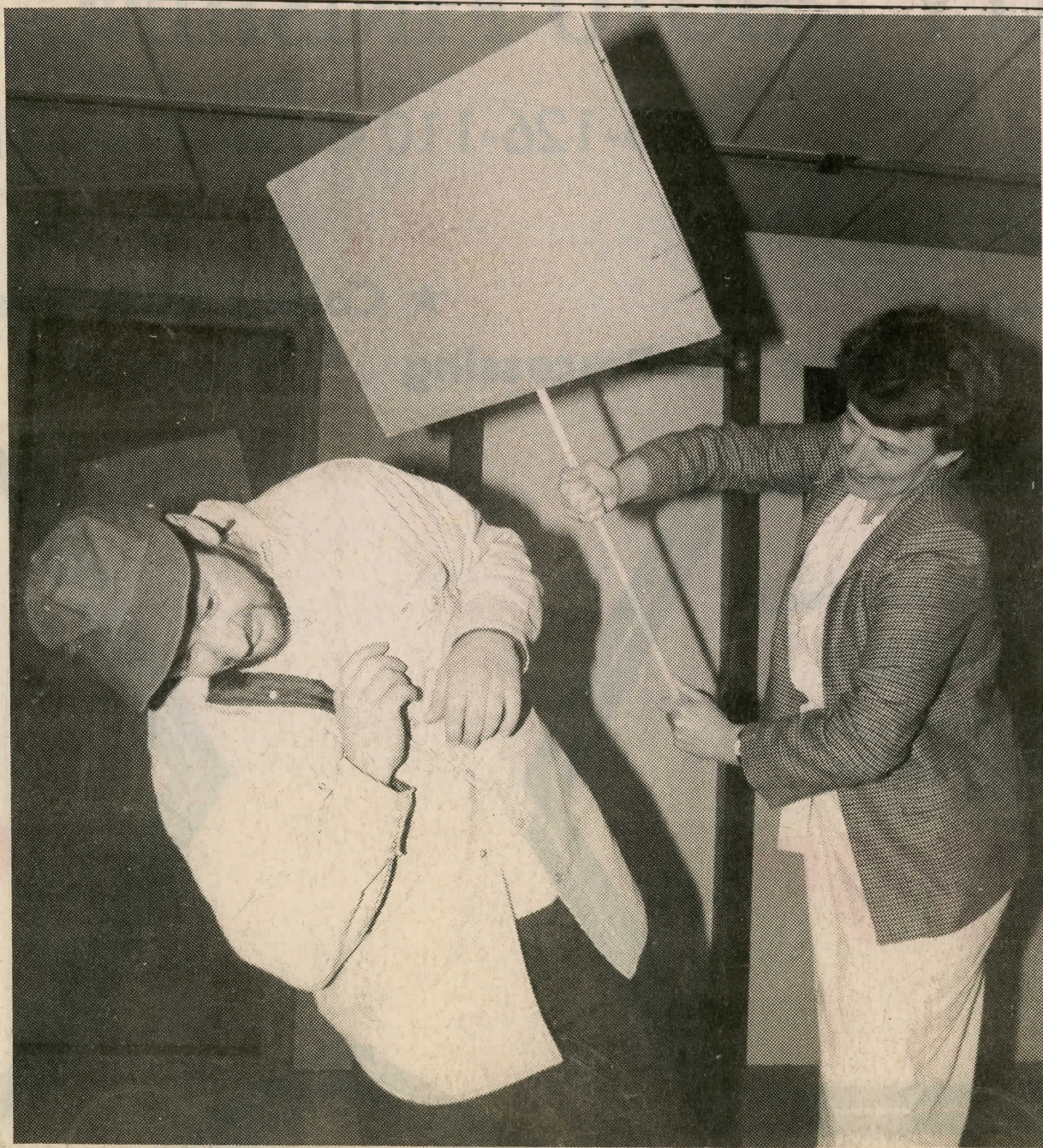

Auditions for spring productions and new courses are set for Stage North, Northern Light College Theatre.

Stage North will hold auditions for 3 one-act Chekhov comedies Dec 2, 3 and 4. Rehearsals for *The Bear*, *The Proposal* and *Jubilee* will start Jan 13, while performances will run Feb 26-Mar 14.

Men and women of all ages are required for the cast and are welcome to inquire about assisting in set and costume construction and stage crews.

Stage North is also offering four new theatre courses starting in January.

Great Plays centres on reading and discussion of the most exciting and influential plays of the 19th and 20th centuries, with emphasis on contemporary works.

Fred Galloway will teach that course and Mime — a course showing how to move with style and grace while telling a story without words.

Michael Puttonen will be the instructor for Basic Acting, a course for students with experience on stage and for those who want to find out what acting is all about. Emphasis will be on relaxation, enjoyment of the art, clarity of expression and making a character come to life on stage.

Sonia Lazarus will teach Basic Theatre Design, which will include instruction in constructing and designing sets, costumes and lighting systems.
